

Student Ministry • W | STUDENTS (Middle & High School)

Small Group Leader: Each week, small group leaders spend 30 minutes discussing the lessons and how it applies to the individual students. Students build relationships with these leaders and look up to them as a source of guidance and mentoring.

Security: These volunteers ensure a safe experience for students on Wednesday nights. While most of these volunteers are walking the building, we also have ways to serve on our security team that are more behind the scenes.

Set-Up/Tear-Down: The set-up/tear-down crew is a bit more behind the scenes, but still incredibly important. These volunteers arrive early on Wednesday nights to set up and/or stay late to tear-down. Must be able to lift, bend, and carry up to 20lbs.

WellSpring Prime (55+ Ministry)

Prime Pro-Team: This team is on-call for Prime members who need minor home maintenance or repair, or simply need someone familiar with such to come look a situation over and advise. Perfect for those with any handyman skills, or merely glad to be available to help.

Prime Prayer Team: This team maintains a current list of families and individuals asking for prayer. Updated prayer lists are sent out each week with the expectation of prayer coverage with confidentiality.

Prime Textworking Team: The Textworking Team specializes in reminding people that they are being thought of and prayed for on a regular basis. Team members can work from the comfort of their own phones, texting Prime adults twice a month with a simple message that they have been thought of and prayed for.

Local Missions & Outreach

Nashville Rescue Mission Team: This group regularly visits the Nashville Rescue Mission's men's and women's facilities to bring Jesus to the hungry, homeless, and hurting. Opportunities include food prep and serving.

The JetPack Project: This backpack program provides nutritious, non-perishable food for the weekend to eligible children of food-deficient households. This team meets to pack the food that will be sent home with kids in local schools. All ages are welcome to pack. JetPack deliveries to the schools are made on Thursday mornings and require a once-a-month commitment.

The Well Outreach: In 2006, WellSpring started The Well, a local food pantry and outreach that grew to into its own nonprofit organization. There are regular opportunities to help at The Well food pantry or at one of their Mobile Food Pantries. Join one of WellSpring's two Wednesday night serving groups.

Connections/Discipleship

Group Hosts & Leaders: This team works to better connect individuals to the WellSpring community and aids them in deepening their walk with Jesus. While LifeGroups, Bible Studies, and Interest Groups have a slightly different focus, all of them directly help with WellSpring's mission to "Help People Follow Jesus."

Photographers/Videographers: This team helps to capture all that God is doing in and through WellSpring at different events through pictures and videos.

Adult Teams: Whether it's a women's, men's, or church wide event, there are seasonal opportunities when all sorts of teams are needed to make these events a success.

Kids • W | KIDS (Birth-Grade 5)

Birth-PreK Teacher: We have classes available for infants through preschoolers and rely on so many safe and trusted leaders to teach them, attend to their needs, and help them know church is a safe space. These leaders use materials provided for them to help kids engage with God and with the world He created.

Birth-PreK Helper: Each classroom has a helper who assists the teacher with the nurture and care of each kid. Helpers play with the kids, hand out supplies, help kids with crafts and activities, and assist the teacher in a variety of ways.

Elementary Teacher: To ensure each elementary-aged kid gets individual care and attention, we have age-specific small groups for kindergarten-5th grade. Leaders use provided games, crafts, and Bible stories to help their small group learn who God is and that He is a God they can trust.

Elementary Helper: Each small group has a helper who assists the teacher with the care of each kid, redirecting kids as needed and making sure each kid feels known.

Elementary Buddy: Some kids in our ministry have additional needs, and elementary buddies help make sure those needs are met. Buddies are paired with a kid and provide support and encouragement as needed.

PreK Hall Floater: Floaters welcome each family down the PreK hall, help during service with kids that need additional support, guide classes on and off the playground, print rosters, and ensure the service goes smoothly.

Elementary Floater: Floaters stay in the Theater throughout service, checking on the small groups, helping with kids that need additional support, directing kids that come in late, and assisting with transitions.

Kids Welcome Team: Greeters stand at the kids check-in station to welcome families and assist with any computer check-in issues. They also help first-time families get checked in and walked to their classroom.

Hospitality & Facilities

Facilities & Maintenance: This team works on upkeep, repairs, maintenance, and improvements around our campus and grounds during the week.

Office Volunteers: This team aids our church office staff by helping with administrative tasks, organization, and some light cleaning.

Set Up & Tear Down Teams: This team sets up signage and classroom furniture before our first Sunday worship service. Others stick around after our final worship service to get the building "pre-school ready" again for our pre-school, The Academy at WellSpring!

First Team: This team is the first that most people encounter when attending WellSpring on Sundays and is made up of multiple smaller teams. Outside, you'll find the friendly faces of our [Parking Attendants](#) and [Door Greeters](#); inside, the [Coffee Hosts](#) work to make sure there is plenty of coffee in the lobby while the [Welcome Desk Hosts](#) are available to answer questions and give info packets and a welcome gift to new attenders. [Ushers](#) help pass out communion and ensure guests can find a seat. [The Communion Prep team](#) works behind the scenes to make sure the communion trays are filled for each worship service. [Worship breakfast team](#) members bring food for our worship team and staff members who arrive early on Sunday mornings.

Security Team: This behind-the-scenes team works to ensure safety on Sunday mornings and during other WellSpring events.

Worship Arts

Worship leaders and band: Through vocals and musical instruments, dynamic teams prepare the way for those in attendance on Sunday morning to encounter the presence of the living God.

Technical Production: This team is made up of many smaller teams such as sound techs, graphics techs, camera techs, lighting techs, and stage designers.

Sunday Morning Prayer Team: The backbone of our worship starts with these prayer warriors. Each Sunday, this team spends time praying for the service and through a list of WellSpring prayer requests.
